Who supported Mr. Brooks? What reasons do they give for their support?	Who opposed Mr. Brooks? What reasons do they give for their opposition?
Who supported Mr. Brooks? -A minority of the Little Rock School Board -Support from the white community	Who opposed Mr. Brooks? -A majority of the Little Rock School Board -Opposition from African Americans
What reasons do they give for their support? -Test scores have improved -"He cares about the kids," said one supporter	What reasons do they give for their opposition? -Job cuts decrease the black middle class -Mr. Brooks does not identify with black people
