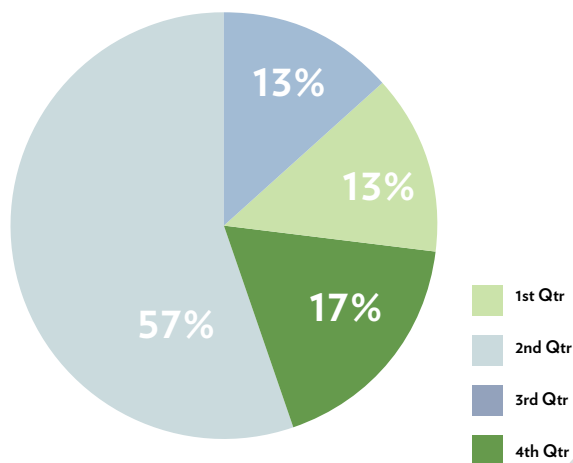


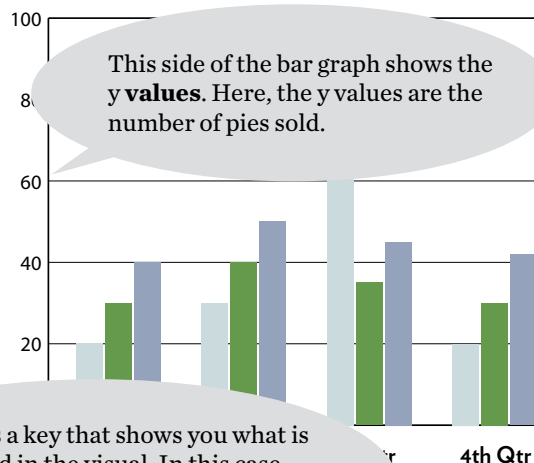
Understanding Visuals

The **title** of a visual tells you what information is being presented. Here, this visual shows how many pies were baked in 2010.

PIES SOLD BY BAKERS IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE CITY

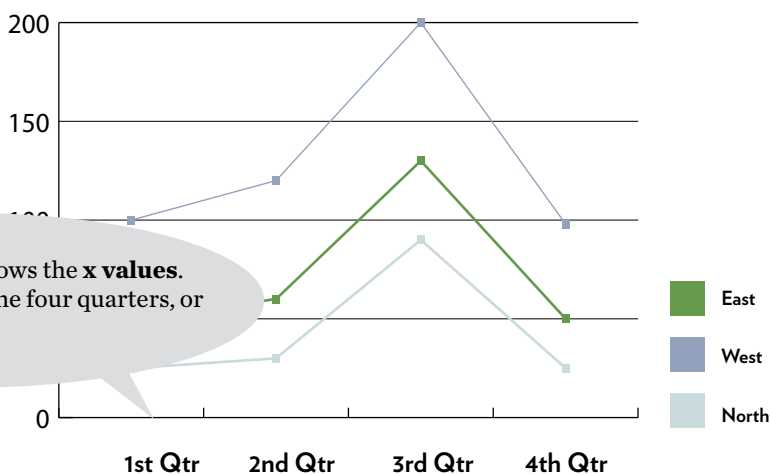


This side of the bar graph shows the **y values**. Here, the y values are the number of pies sold.

A **legend** is a key that shows you what is represented in the visual. In this case, the colors of the pie chart represent each quarter of the year.

Here is another type of visual, a line graph, which shows values as lines.

BAKERIES WITH THE MOST CUSTOMERS



This side of the graph shows the **x values**. In this graph, these are the four quarters, or parts, of the year.
